The assembly focused on sensitizing the kids about the depleting number of tigers and how the tigers are an important part of the ecological balance.

Little Chef's Activity



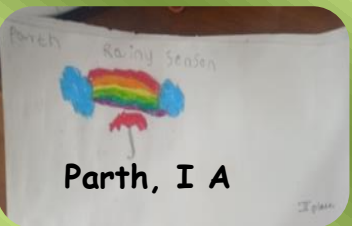
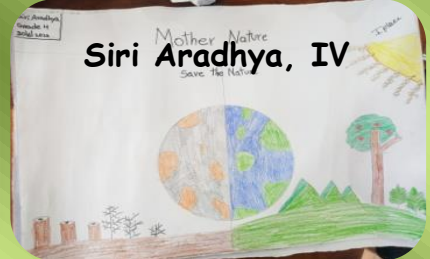

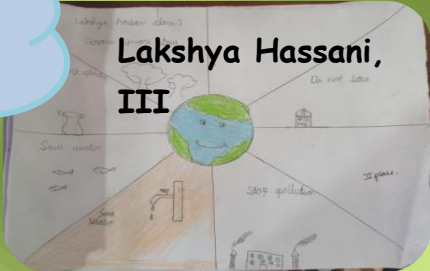
